## **Whole School**

The school is closed to pupils and staff on Monday 2nd May

Thursday 5th May is an In-service day, and unless your young person is sitting an exam (Modern Studies, Advanced Higher, Higher and National 5) on this day they should NOT attend.

#### **Reminders:**

Lateral Flow Test Kits: Please use the kits to keep yourself and others safe by regularly taking a test. LFT kits are only available to pick up from the main office before the start of the school day, breaktime, lunchtime or at the end of the day, unless there is immediate need.

**Face coverings** –Stocks of face coverings are available for those who wish to wear a face covering. Guidance still recommends that these are worn in common areas and whilst moving about the school.

**School Uniform** - All young people are expected to wear school uniform including blazers and ties at all times, ties can be purchased from the school office at a cost of £4. Any young person who requires support from the school with regards to uniform should see their guidance teacher in the first instance. All young people should change into and out of PE kit following PE lessons.

<u>CORRIDORS:</u> The first, second and home economics/tech corridors should **not** be use during break and lunchtimes. **Please only use the canteen and outdoor areas, this will ensure areas are kept quiet for exams.** Our S3 prefects will be monitoring these areas and all pupils should follow any instructions given by the prefects. Pupils should only be in corridors if they are going to see a specific teacher, however, please be mindful of exams taking place and take note of any signage.
